





Self-Enquiry 'Vichara Sangraham' of Bhagavan Sri Ramana Maharshi


This work consists of 40 questions with answers covering the entire range of spiritual disciplines required for the gaining of *moksha*. The questioner Gambiram Seshayya, approached Bhagavan for resolving his difficulties. Bhagavan, who was only 21 years old, wrote out his answers on bits of paper. These writings over the period of 1900 -1902 were later copied in a note-book by Seshaya.




Sri Ramana Gita composed by Sri Vasishtha Ganapati Muni



This is the most comprehensive collection of the Maharshi's sayings composed and strung together artistically by the poet Sri Muruganar. Each stanza presents, in a well wrought and finely polished setting, a pearl that fell from the Master's lips. Most of these stanzas were seen and approved by the Master, who supplied some links and re-statements to emphasize a point.

Kunjuswami's Reminiscences provide a rare, first-hand account of the early days of Sri Ramanasramam and life at Skandasramam.






A Guide to Giripradakshina
